Graduate Student Technology Grant Application 2026-2027 (Ph.D. students)

Ph.D. students who maintain 'good academic standing' (i.e. passed PhD qualifying exams, and/or have had regular annual supervisory committee meetings) may receive up to \$1,000 through April 30th, 2027 towards expenses associated with improvement of their work-related hardware, buying needed educational and scientific software, or taking online courses directly related to their research program. Reimbursement takes place **after** items have been purchased. *Students are eligible for this once for the duration of their programs. **Submit this completed form (signed by both the student and supervisor) and upload all receipts and statements using Concur.** **Note that the Division on Concur is 'Arts and Science' and the department is 'Cell and Systems Biology'. You do not need to enter anything for Cost Centre or Fund Centre (they should both be listed as 'unknown').
